Norma Hecker - one-woman show at the Contemporary Art Museum of Bedarieux. Showing paintings, prints, drawings, and large paper projects. Having studied in America and Germany, Norma Hecker settled in the South of France, and started working as a weaver. Next, she began making her own large-scale tapestries... From this moment on, her creations (drawing, paintings, and tapestries), which include both large abstract works and small formats, focus on hand movement, evoking the Oriental art of calligraphy, followed up on a study trip to China. In addition, in drawing and painting, the interplay of scales she uses is illustrative of her penchant for the notions of macrocosm and microcosm, born of a long tradition of esotericism and alchemy. In fact, Norma Hecker considers that any work – monumental or not – is but a fragment of a general creation. Since 1991 Norma Hecker lives and works at the ATELIER DE LAURENQUE near ROQUEBRUN (Hérault), and more recently, also in SETE.
